

GENERAL EMERGENCY WARRANTY

1.0 mcPhilben emergency exit and unit equipment (excluding lamps, pilot lights, and fuses) are fully warranted to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use for a period of five years from the date of installation, unless otherwise stated.

2.0 The full warranty period begins on the date of installation or 90 days from date of shipment whichever date is earlier.

2.1 Should a defect appear in the equipment or batteries within the specified warranty period, mcPhilben will repair or replace equipment without charge. Such repair or replacement shall be purchaser's exclusive remedy.

3.0 All warranties are subject to proper installation and maintenance in accordance with the instructions supplied.

3.1 Any material determined to be defective is to be returned to the factory for evaluation. Any changes in circuiting or components by other than authorized mcPhilben personnel or its service companies will void the warranty.

3.2 If new replacement parts are shipped before defective goods are received for evaluation, the replacement parts will be invoiced at the net price in effect at that time. These charges will be credited if, upon receipt and evaluation of goods, a defect is determined. AT NO TIME WILL NEW UNIT EQUIPMENT BE SHIPPED FOR REPLACEMENT PURPOSES. Units returned after installation cannot be restored to 100% saleable condition.

4.0 This warranty does not cover damages caused by installation in areas with other than normal temperatures and environmental conditions per application specifications. mcPhilben assumes no responsibility for any damage to people, property, apparatus or otherwise resulting from improper installation or maintenance of its emergency lighting equipment.

4.1 This warranty does not cover damages caused by abuse, fire or Acts of God.

4.2 In no event shall mcPhilben be liable for incidental or consequential damages.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions set forth will void the warranty. Any exceptions to the foregoing warranty must be requested and approved prior to initial shipment.
