

Limited Warranty

Day-Brite HID warrants to Purchaser that the factory installed electrical and control system (consisting of a core and coil ballast, ignitor, capacitor, socket and wiring, including ballast assembly and Hi/Lo electrical controls) inside its HID lighting luminaires as well as all controlling Hi/Lo occupancy detection equipment supplied by Day-Brite Lighting will be free from defects in material and workmanship for five (5) years from the later of date of manufacture, or from the date that the luminaires and/or controls are shipped from Manufacturer's factory, whichever period Purchaser can substantiate. The term "Purchaser" means a purchaser for resale or for use in business.

If any of Day-Brite's products fail to meet Day-Brite's warranty, Day-Brite shall correct the defects by shipping to Purchaser the necessary repaired or replacement part (at Day-Brite's sole option) F.O.B. Day-Brite's factory with freight allowed to destination within the continental United States. The warranty set forth in this document is VOID if the products have not been properly stored, installed or maintained or if Purchaser fails to comply with any applicable recommendations of Day-Brite. No product may be returned until Purchaser has contacted Day-Brite and received a return authorization. Day-Brite shall not be responsible for any power failure; improper power supply; fault or negligence of the Purchaser or user; improper or unauthorized use, installation, handling, storage, alteration or service; or any cause other than a defect in the material or workmanship of the product itself. Day-Brite makes no warranty to those defined as consumers in the Magnuson-Moss Federal Trade Commission Improvement Act.

This is Day-Brite's only warranty and Purchaser's exclusive remedy with respect to the HID products listed. **DAY-BRITE SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, SAID DISCLAIMER EXTENDING TO THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.**

Purchaser's exclusive remedy as stated is for warranty claims or otherwise. In no event shall the Purchaser's remedy include labor or incidental or consequential damages, the remedy having been limited exclusively to repair or replacement as set forth above.
